



Sam's Story Attendance Matters




Sam has just started Year 11. His attendance rate is always around 90%. He thinks this is pretty good!

So, what does an attendance rate of 90% look like?



90% attendance means that he is absent from lessons for the equivalent of one half-day every week!




Absent half a day every week



In Grade 9 Sam's 90% attendance rate means that he has missed the equivalent of four whole weeks of lessons in the school year.

38 school weeks





If Sam continues to attend for only 90% of the time then over five years he will have missed the equivalent of about one half of a school year!



Every School Day Counts

365 Days in a Year	190 School Days in Total	<u>Absence</u>
100% attendance	190 days attendance	0
95% attendance	180 days attendance	2 weeks absence
90% attendance	171 days attendance	4 weeks absence
85% attendance	161 days attendance	6 weeks absence
80% attendance	152 days attendance	More than half a term absence
75% attendance	143 days attendance	9+ weeks absence
